



Energy NL Rising Star Award Criteria

Energy NL's Rising Star Award recognizes outstanding achievement by an impressive individual 40 years old or under who has made remarkable strides in their role within the Newfoundland and Labrador energy industry.

Energy NL's Industry Achievement Awards Gala will take place October 29, 2026.

Nominations will be evaluated based upon the following criteria:

Personal Criteria:

The nominee must be 40 years of age or under as of December 31st, 2026* and have worked within the energy industry in Newfoundland and Labrador for a minimum of two years. The nominee must be an Energy NL member or work for an Energy NL member company/organization.

Professional Achievement:

The nominee is a mid-career professional who has already made a significant contribution to their company and the Newfoundland and Labrador energy industry.

Integrity:

The nominee has set high professional standards for the industry in both ethics and quality of work.

Results:

The nominee has demonstrated impressive actions that will lead to future impactful contributions to the energy industry of Newfoundland and Labrador. Education and volunteer/community outreach activities will also be considered.

Advocacy:

The nominee has promoted, marketed and been a strong advocate for the energy industry in Newfoundland and Labrador.

Industry Recognition:

The nominee has been recently endorsed by a senior representative from the energy industry. This endorsement must accompany this nomination.

Nominations must be seconded.
